## Reading Role Models

Parent involvement in early literacy has a strong impact on a child's academic achievement. Although children are taught to read in kindergarten, they develop important early literacy skills in the first five years of their lives, even before they enter the classroom. These skills are developed by singing, storytelling, reading/repeating nursery rhymes, being read to, looking at picture books, conversations that build vocabulary, and writing (scribbling counts)!
